APA Audition Requirements 2024-2025 School Year

To audition or interview for APA, you must ensure that you have submitted the complete APA application to the APA office **Friday, January 26th, 2024**. The complete APA application includes:

- Application Cover Page and paperwork (pages 7-9)
- Your photo affixed to the Cover Page
- Résumé (a sample is enclosed)
- Personal Essay (instructions enclosed)
- One (1) Instructor Recommendation Form
- Unofficial copy of transcript or latest report card
- \$10 application donation
- For MMET: Media and Musical Theatre *only*: videos due **Friday, January 26th, 2024**.

Below are the 2024-2025 APA audition requirements, listed by department. Please read through the guidelines for the department(s) you are auditioning or interviewing for. The APA Office will arrange the audition or interview time with applicants based upon Director availability. The APA office will notify you a week before auditions of your specific audition date and time. *We wish you the very best of luck!*

DEPARTMENT	AUDITION REQUIREMENTS
Acting	<p>Perform 2 one-minute memorized monologues: 1 comedy and 1 drama It is advisable that one monologue is a character close to you in terms of age and personality. The other monologue should show your range in terms of playing a challenging character. Monologues should be from published plays.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Introduce each monologue by the name of the play, the author, and the character you are performing ● Monologues from plays/scripts can be found on the internet or at your local library
Costume Design	<p>Interview with Costume Design faculty and presentation of portfolio or samples, if available. Please be prepared to answer this question: <i>“Why do you want to be a member of the APA Costume Design department?”</i></p>
Dance	<p>Learn a ballet barre, jazz progression, modern combination, and tap sequence on site.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Prior technical training <i>required</i> ● Attire: dark leotard, pink or black tights, hair back. Bring jazz shoes & ballet slippers. tap shoes optional
Dramatic Production <i>Playwriting & Directing</i>	<p>Presentation of a portfolio, if available. Playwrights: Bring writing samples of plays, short stories, poems, etc. Directors: Expect a short interview in which you will talk about your leadership potential and creative ideas</p>
Musical Theatre	<p>This department calls for a live audition as well as a video audition (singing portion only) due on Friday, January 26th, 2024.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Submit your vocal audition video: Submit a video of 32 bars of an up-tempo Broadway Standard or contemporary up-tempo Broadway song <u>AND</u> 16 bars of a Broadway Standard Ballad or contemporary Broadway Ballad. Submissions may be with a track or with an accompanist. Videos must be uploaded to a platform such as YouTube or Vimeo. Email video links to apamtdept@gmail.com by January 26th, 2024. Subject line should read: <i>MT Audition</i> and your name. 2. Live auditions, consisting of three components: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● SING: Perform 32 bars of an up-tempo Broadway Standard and 16 bars of a contemporary Broadway Ballad (song selections may be the same as your audition video). Please bring your sheet music in the correct key. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ On audition day, you may be asked to perform only a portion of your music, but be prepared to perform the entire selection if asked. ● DANCE: Learn and perform a short dance combination on-site at auditions ● ACT: Perform one (1) memorized monologue from a Broadway musical. Introduce the monologue by the name of the musical and the character you are performing.

MMET: Media	<p>All students will be interviewed by Mr. Simmons and are to produce and submit a 3-minute (maximum) video about themselves.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make a 3-minute film that demonstrates your creativity, style, and skills in filmmaking. • Videos should be uploaded to a platform such as YouTube or Google Drive. Email video links to Mr. Simmons at msimmons@hbuhdsd.edu by Friday, January 26th, 2024.
MMET: Popular Music	<p>VOCALISTS:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Vocalists will be brought into the MMET studio for ear testing as a group. 2. Be prepared to sing one (1) pop or rock song of <i>your choice</i>. Please bring your own accompaniment (such as a karaoke track in your preferred key). You will not be permitted to sing acapella. 3. Please visit bit.ly/MMETAudition. Perform one (1) song from the list provided in the “Vocals” folder. Be prepared to sing one verse and one chorus. <p>INSTRUMENTALISTS:</p> <p>Bring your guitar or bass. You do not need to bring a keyboard, drum set, pedal boards, or amps (these are provided). Know how to plug into an amp and tune your instrument.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be prepared to perform one (1) popular rock or pop song of <i>your choice</i>. Please play a verse and a chorus. If you have a recording to play along with, you may do so. 2. Please read the following carefully, as each instrument has different guidelines for this second step: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Bass Players: Please visit bit.ly/MMETAudition. Perform two (2) songs from the list provided in the “Bass” folder. Please learn the intro, verse, and first chorus to both songs of your choosing. Backing tracks (without bass) can also be found in this folder to practice with. ○ Guitarists: Please visit bit.ly/MMETAudition. Perform two (2) songs from the list provided in the “Guitar” folder. Please learn the intro, verse, and first chorus to both songs of your choosing. Backing tracks (without guitar) can also be found in this folder to practice with. ○ Drums: Please visit bit.ly/MMETAudition. Perform two (2) songs from the list provided in the “Drums” folder. Please learn the intro, verse, and first chorus to both songs of your choosing. Backing tracks (without drums) can also be found in this folder to practice with. ○ Keys: Please visit bit.ly/MMETAudition. Perform two (2) songs from the list provided in the “Keys” folder. Please learn the intro, verse, and first chorus to both songs of your choosing. Backing tracks (without keys) can also be found in this folder.
Orchestra <i>Traditional Music Program</i>	<p>Play 1-2 short selections (3-minutes maximum) which best demonstrate your musical and technical ability. Expect a short excerpt to sight-read.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play scales from memory as follows (two octaves when possible): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Wind instruments: B-flat, E-flat, A-flat, F, C, chromatic (from your lowest note to highest note - show your range) ○ String instruments: C, G, D, A, F, chromatic (from your lowest note to highest note - show your range) ○ Piano: F, C, G (2 hands), 2 octave chromatic C-C ○ Guitar, drum set: demonstrate the following styles - swing, rock, Latin ○ Concert percussion (in addition to 1-2 short selections: keyboard marimba, bells, etc.): C, B-flat, E-flat scales, concert snare drum-roll soft to loud to soft. • Bring your instrument and sheet music. A piano, all percussion, and guitar amp are available.
Technical Theatre	<p>All students will be interviewed by Technical Theatre faculty, and may prepare the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A presentation of portfolio samples in the areas of Technical Theatre, <i>only if applicable</i> (such as past examples of lighting, sound, set design, painting, stage management, etc.). 2. Speak on your supporting abilities for Technical Theatre (such as skills in drawing, painting, carpentry, craftsmanship, technical skills, or other hobbies/occupational interests). 3. Please be prepared to answer questions regarding Technical Theatre, such as why you are interested in the department, what experience you have, moments you have prioritized safety and communication, and an achievement you are most proud of. 4. You are welcome to ask Mr. Behrens and Mr. Henderson any questions you may have about the program and department.
